To ensure high quality, all papers will be thoroughly reviewed by the CISTEF 2017 Program Committee. All accepted papers must be presented by one of the authors who must register for the conference and pay the fee. The conference proceedings will be published by Springer in the prestigious series LNCS/LNAI (indexed by ISI CPCI-S, included in ISI Web of Science, EI, ACM Digital Library, DBLP, Google Scholar, Scopus, etc.).
